East Seventy (70) feet of Lots One (1) and Two (2) in Block One (1), North, Tulsa, Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory, now Oklahoma.

This deed being made to release (only so far as it affects the above described property) the lien of certain mortgages dated - April 18th, 1906 - April 18th, 1906 - 1906th recorded April 19th, 1906 - 1906 at - 8 a.m. - M. in Book - 12 - at Page - 301 - of the records of Mortgages at Sapulpa and Claremore Ind. Terr.

This deed of release is made by the undersigned officer of the Union Trust Company in pursuance of the authority conferred upon him in Article VII of the by-laws of said Company, as follows:
