 Whereas John F. Warren the
 the United States Court for the Northern District
 of Indian Territory, duly appointed curator of the
 estates of Thompson Montgomery, Eliza Mont-
 gomery, Joe Bell Montgomery, Hattie Mont-
 gomery, Geo. Montgomery Jr., and Alfred
 Montgomery the sole heirs at law of Henry
 Montgomery, deceased, all citizens of the Creek
 Nation Indian Territory and Okmulgee,

The said Henry Montgomery, died on the
 eighth day of July, 1901, and

Whereas, the said John F. Warren
 curator heretofore on the 13th day of July
 1907 ordered made application to the United
 States Court for the Northern District of Indian
 Territory sitting at Vinita in Probate Case
 No. 187 for an order of sale of the interests of
 all of said minors in and to the allotment
 of the said Henry Montgomery deceased for the
 purpose of educating and supporting his
 said wards out of the proceeds thereof and

Whereas, the said Court on the 13th day of July
 1907 ordered the interests of the said minors
 in and to the allotment of the said Henry
 Montgomery deceased to be sold subject to the
 life estate therein of George B. Montgomery and
 Bessie Montgomery, the father and mother
 respectively of the said Henry Montgomery
 deceased, and

Whereas, in accordance with the said
 order of sale the said Curator did on the 16th
 day of September, 1907 at the hour of two
 o'clock P. M., offer for sale at the door of
 the United States Court House in Vinita
 Indian Territory in accordance with the
 said order of said Court all of the said
 allotment of Henry Montgomery deceased subject
 to the life estate of the said father and mother and
