Agricultural Leases.

These Indentures made and entered
into this 23 day of December 1907

Witnesseth, that the said party of the first part found in consideration of the covenants of the said party of the second part hereinafter set forth do by these presents lease to said party of the second part, for agricultural purposes, the following land lying and being within the Cherokee Nation Indian Territory, to wit:

One hundred (\$100.00) dollars, being at the rate of \$1.00 dollar per acre, payable as follows, to wit:

Said party of the second part further covenants and agrees that he will at his own expense within ⁶ years from the date of the contract ⁶

It is further understood and agreed by the parties hereto, that all buildings and improvements shall remain a part of said land and become the property of the owner of the land at the expiration of this lease as a part of the consideration of the lease. In testimony whereof the parties of the first and second part have herunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first above written.
