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Warranty Deed.

Know all men by these presents:

That the Albama Transit Company, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the Act of Congress of February 15, 1901, providing for the formation of Corporations in the Indian Territory, in consideration of ^{fully} \$41.00 Dollars - cash in hand, paid to it by Lee May Long, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Lee May Long all the following described parcel of land, situate in the Town of Albama, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, (according to the survey and plat of town embodied in the land divided as the east half of the southwest quarter and lot three (3) of section thirty (30) Township twenty (20) Range fourteen (14) east according to the United States Survey) - said parcel of land being known and designated upon the plat thereof as:

Lot number eleven (11), Block number twenty-one (21), together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereto belonging, and warrants its title to the same. To have and to hold the aforementioned premises unto the said Lee May Long and her heirs, successors and assigns, forever, free, clear and discharged of and from all former grants, charges, taxes, judgments, mortgages and other liens and encumbrances of whatever nature.
