

Agreement and Contract

This contract and agreement is made and entered into this the 30th Dec. 1907, by and between R. M. Honey - a party of the first part and Robt. Chapman - a party of the second part, witnesses. The party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of \$500.00 as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith and due 10 months from date, with interest at the rate of 8 1/2% per annum from date, does hereby bargain and sell unto the second party, the whet building, size 14x24, and all log house and hog wire on the N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 14-19-13, Creek Nation, Okla.

The second party agrees to pay the said note for \$500.00 when due, and it is further mutually agreed and understood by all parties that the said improvements herein mentioned shall remain as security for the purchase price until the same is paid, and in case of the default of the second party to pay the when due, the first party reserves the right to take possession of the property above mentioned, without any further process of law.
