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Deed of Release.

D. L. Sleeper,

Know all 'em By These Presents:

That the Union Trust Company (an Indian Territory Corporation) of Tulsa, Ind. Ter., for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Hundred Twenty-six 67/100 Dollars, to it paid by D. L. Sleeper does hereby grant, sell, quit claim and release unto the said D. L. Sleeper & Della B. Sleeper, and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in the Eastern District, of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The north half of the southwest quarter (N. 1/2 S. W. 1/4) and the south-west quarter of the south-west quarter (S. W. 1/4 S. W. 1/4) of Section Eighteen (18) Township nineteen (19) north, Range Twelve (12) East, being the north-east quarter of the south-west quarter (N. E. 1/4 S. W. 1/4) and Lot Five (5) and the East thirty-eight (38) acres of Lot Four (4) of said Section, Township and range, containing 119.90 acres, more or less.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain mortgage dated January 2nd, 1907, and recorded January 2nd, 1907, at 4:20 P.M. in Book 11, at Page 5 of the records of Mortgages at Tulsa, Ind. Ter.

This deed of release is made by the undersigned officer of the Union Trust Company in pursuance of the authority conferred upon him in Article VIII of the by-laws of said company, as follows:

"The Secretary shall have equal power with The President to satisfy and release mortgages; judgments or certificates of trust; to execute contracts, releases or other instruments in the transaction of the company's business."
