That I, Joseph O. Scharble, an unmarried man of Tulsa, Indian Territory, for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred Dollars cash in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged having been paid by G. M. Gimner have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed and by these presents do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said G. M. Gimner and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following land lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit: all of that portion of the north one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the north-east quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the south-west quarter of section twelve (12) Township twenty two (22) north, Range twelve (12) East, lying west of Shallow Creek, in the Cherokee nation containing sixteen acres more or less as the case may be.

To have and to hold the above described premises, together with all and singular, the rights and appurtenances thereto in anywise belonging, unto the said G. M. Gimner, his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said premises unto the said G. M. Gimner, heirs and assigns, against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
