Warranty Deed

Know all men by these presents, that I, Lawyer Deer of Yager, Western District of the Indian Territory, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other good and valuable considerations to me in hand paid by Chas. Bagg, of Muskogee, Western District of the Indian Territory, the receipt of which I hereby acknowledge, have this day given, granted, bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Chas. Bagg and unto his heirs, an undivided one-fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) in and to the following described lots or parcels of land situated in the Western District of the Indian Territory to-wit: The Southeast quarter (S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest quarter (N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$) of section thirty seven (37), Township nineteen (19) North, Range twelve (12) East; also the Southeast quarter (S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast quarter (N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$) of section thirty one (31); also the Southwest quarter (S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest quarter (N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$) and Lot three (3) of section thirty two (32) of Township eighteen (18) North of Range thirteen (13) East; with all the rights, privileges and immunities therunto belonging or in anywise appertaining:

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises unto the said Chas. Bagg and his heirs in fee simple forever; and I, the said Lawyer Deer, for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, do covenant with the said Chas. Bagg and his heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that they are free from all incumbrance; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Chas. Bagg as aforesaid; and that I will, and my heirs executors and administrators shall, warrant and defend the same to the said Chas. Bagg and his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.

And for the considerations aforesaid, and for diverse other good and valuable considerations, I, Hepsy Deer wife of the said Lawyer Deer, do hereby release and quitclaim unto the said Chas. Bagg, his heirs and assigns, all my right, claim or possibility of dower in or out of the aforesigned premises.
