This conveyance, made and entered into this 8th day of August 1907, between Ida Childers, a single woman of Coweta, Indian Territory, party of the first part, and Ellis N. Hammett, A. C. Allen and J. C. Pinson, co-partners, doing business under the firm name and style of the Coweta Realty Company of Coweta I. T. parties of the second part.

Witnesseth, that the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum One thousand Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and other valuable consideration does by these presents, grant, sell, bargain and convey unto the said parties of the second part, their heirs successors and assigns, all the following described real estate and premises situated in the Creek Nation, Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The North East quarter of section twenty-four (24) Township eighteen (18) North, and Range fourteen (14) East, known as the lands allotted to Tiller Beaver, deceased.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the cements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And the said party of the first part, for her heirs, executors, or administrators, does hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with the said parties of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents, she is lawfully seized in her own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free from all incumbrances of what nature or kind so ever, and that she will warrant and forever defend the same unto said parties of the second part their heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part, her heirs, and all or every person or persons, whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
