Quitclaim deed. With relinquishment of Dower.

This instrument, Made this 15th day of August  
A.D. 1907 between P. C. Hickman and Anna  
Hickman his wife of Muskogee Indian  
Territory Western District party of the first part, and  
Willie Grayson of Beggs Indian Territory - District  
party of the second part.

Witnesseth; That the said part - of the first part, for  
and in consideration of the sum of One dollar and  
other Valuable Considerations Dollars, in hand paid  
by the said part - of the second part (there receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged) have devised, released,  
sold, conveyed and quit claimed, and by these presents do  
devise, release, sell and convey and quit claim unto  
the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns  
forever all the right title, interest, claim and demand  
which said party of the first part - in and to the  
following described lot, place or parcel of land or  
improvements situated in the Creek - Indian Territory  
Western District, and known and described as follows,  
to-wit: The Northwest quarter of the South  
West quarter of section Twenty (20) Township Nineteen  
(19) North Range Fourteen (14) East.

and el Anna Hickman wife of the said P.  
C. Hickman for and in consideration of the said sum  
of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto  
the said part - of the second part all my right of  
dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the same, together with all  
and singular the appurtenances and privileges  
therunto belonging or appertaining and all the  
estate, right, title, interest and claim whatever  
of the said part - of the first part, either in  
law or equity, to the only proper use, benefit and  
behalf of the said part - of the second part - to  
heirs and assigns forever
