This agreement made and entered into this the 8th day of August, 1907, by and between William Billy of Cuscuta, Indian Territory, party of the first part, and M. M. Schantz of Muskogee, Indian Territory party of the second part, witnesseth:-

That the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars annually, the receipt of the first payment being hereby acknowledged does hereby let, rent and lease unto said second party, for agricultural purposes, for a period of five years the following described land and premises situated in the Creek Nation, Western District, Indian Territory to-wit:- the South East Quarter of the North East Quarter of Section Thirty-two (32), Township Seventeen (17) North, and Range Fourteen (14) East, containing Forty (40) acres more or less, according to the United States Government survey. Whereof, said term to begin on the 8th day of August, 1907, and to end on the 8th day of August, 1912.
