Soper, James H. Huckleberry Thomas H. Owen, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, and sold and do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said P.L. Soper James H. Huckleberry and Thomas H. Owen and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate situated in the Town of — County of Cherokee Nation Indian Territory, in Northern District of the United States Court for the Indian Territory, to wit: The South East quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the South east quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) all in Section eleven (11) Township Twenty (20), North Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Meridian with all the privileges, appurtenances thereupon situate, appertaining and belonging.

To Have and To Hold the same unto the said P.L. Soper, James H. Huckleberry and Thomas H. Owen their heirs and assigns in fee simple forever. And I the said James Wolfe for myself my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said P.L. Soper James H. Huckleberry and Thomas H.
