Assignment of Mortgage with Note.

Know All Men by These Presents, That I, J. L. Hollenberger, of Chicago, Ill., in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars, lawful money of the United States, to me paid before the executing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have sold, assigned transferred and set over, and by these presents do sell, assign, transfer and set over unto Virginia J. Hollenberger of Chicago Ill., a certain indenture of Mortgage bearing date the 12th day of February 1907, made by L. K. Bone and Edith M. Bone of Tulsa Okla. to secure the payment of Fifteen Hundred Dollars, payable March 1st 1909, with interest semi-annually at the rate of eight per cent (which mortgage was recorded on the 28th day of February, 1907, at one o'clock P.M., in Book 7, Page 261) together with the note described thereby and the money due and to grow due thereon with interest; to have and to hold the same unto the said Virginia J.
