Know all men by these Presents: that the Union Trust Company (an Indian Territory corporation of Tulsa Ind. Ter., for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Seventy \$100 Dollars to it paid by R. A. Crowell does hereby grant, sell quit-claim and release unto the said R. A. Crowell and Amelia K. Crowell his wife and unto their heirs and assigns forever the following described real estate lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit: Lot five (5) in Block one hundred seventeen (117) in Tulsa Indian Territory; this deed being made to release the lien of a certain mortgage dated January 5th 1907 and recorded January 7th 1907 at 9:40 am, in Book 11 at Page 6 of the records of mortgages at Tulsa Ind. Ter. This deed of release is made by the undersigned officer of the Union Trust Company in pursuance of the authority conferred upon him in Article III of the by-laws of said Company as follows: The secretary shall have equal power with the president to satisfy and release mortgages judgments or certificates of trust; to execute contracts, releases or other instruments in the transaction of the Company's business.
