the following lot lying and situate in the
western district of the Indian Territory more
particularly described as follows (to wit):
To wit three (3) and four (4) in Block
number forty two (42), Original town of Chick-
saw with, all and singular the privileges
incorporeal thereto therewith appurtenant and
appurtenances thereto belonging or in any way
appertaining with all the state title interest of
said party of the first part herein. The said party
of the first part covenants with the said party of the
second part that it is the lawful owner of said tract
of land; that it has no other title thereon and that it is
a lawful right to sell and convey the same.
