Quit-claim deed with relinquishment of dower

Know all men by these presents:

that we, Willoughby Swingle and Cordia Swingle his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One X \$200 Dollars in hand paid by Dollie Bowman party of the second part, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have remised, released, sold, conveyed and quit-claimed and by these presents, do remise, release, sell, and convey and quit-claim unto the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title, interest, claim and demand which said parties of the first part have in and to the following, described lot, piece or parcel of land or improvements, situated in the town of Bixby Indian Territory Western District, and known and described as follows to wit: Lot numbered one (1) in Block numbered twenty three (23) according to the official plat of said town - Bixby Indian Territory

To Have and to Hold the same together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate right title interest and claim, whatever of the said parties of the first part either in law or equity to the only proper use benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever.

And I, Cordie Swingle wife of the said Willoughby Swingle for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Dollie Bowman, all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
