Palmer, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged I have remised released sold conveyed and by these presents do remise release sell, quit, claim and convey unto the said T.R. Palmer and his heirs and assigns all the right title claim and demand the said Ethel Stebbins nee Ethel Palmer ^{having} and to the following described lot, piece, or parcel of land lying and being situated in the ^{outpost} Indian Territory ^{outpost}: The south-half of the S & $\frac{1}{2}$ and the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S & $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section Three (3) Township nineteen 19, north Range Thirteen 13 east.

To Have and to hold the same together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said T.R. Palmer and his heirs and assigns forever free and discharged from the claim of the said Ethel Stebbins, or any person whatsoever claiming or to claim the same by through or under the said Ethel Stebbins but none other.
