Wright has in and to the following described lot piece or parcel of land lying and being situated in the Western Dist. of Creek Nation Indian Territory to wit: -

SW 1/4 of Sec 26, Town 19 N. Range 14 E. To have and to hold the same together with all and singular the appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said Jean Escoc his heirs and assigns forever free and discharged from the claim of the said James B. Wright or any person whomsoever claiming or to claim the same by through or under the said James B. Wright but none other. In Witness Whereof I, the said James B.
