

may be commenced the equal one (one eight $\frac{1}{2}$) part of all the oil produced and saved from the leased premises and to pay Two Hundred dollars per year for the gas from each and every gas well drilled on said premises, the product of which is marketed and used off the premises said payments to be made on each well within sixty days after commencing to use the gas therefrom as aforesaid and to be paid yearly hereafter while the gas from said well is used. In case gas is found in marketable quantities party of the first part shall have gas for domestic purposes free by marketing his own connections. Second party warrants and agrees to locate all wells so as to interfere as little as possible with the cultivated portion of the farm and to protect all lines, and further to complete a well for oil or gas on said premises within four months from the date hereof or pay at the rate of a reasonable sum in advance for each additional month.

Such completion is delayed from the time above mentioned for the completion of such well until a well is completed. Such payment may be made direct to the lessor or by check mailed to him or his assigns at or by check deposited to the credit of Moses Robison or his assigns in the Arkansas Valley Nat. Bank at Broken Arrow C.E. excepting domestic water.

It is agreed that the second party is to have the privilege of using sufficient water from the premises to run all necessary machinery and at any time to remove all machinery and fixtures placed on said premises; and further upon the payment of One Dollar at any time by the party of the second part their heirs, executors, administrators or assigns to the party of the first part his heirs or assigns said
