 Indian Territory for and in consideration of the sum of
 - Dollars to him paid by James P. Allen receipt of
 which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant bargain
 sell and convey unto the said J. P. Allen his
 heirs and assigns forever the following described
 lot or parcel of ground lying and being situated
 in the Cherokee nation of the Indian Territory to wit;
 north half of south west $\frac{1}{4}$ of north east $\frac{1}{4}$ and
 north east $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ and N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of
 S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ all of section 22.20 township no 22
 Range no 15 and S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of
 section 22.24 township no 22 range no 14

To Have and to Hold the same unto the said Jas.
 P. Allen his heirs and assigns forever with all
 appurtenances thereto belonging. and Columbus
 Jordan hereby covenants with the said Jas. P.
 Allen that said lands are free from incum-
 brances that he will forever warrant and
 defend the title to said lands against all
 lawful claims whatsoever & witness hand and
 seal this 4th day of October 1907.
