Warranty Deed.

This Indenture, made and entered into this 9th day of August, one thousand, nine hundred seven, by and between Emma Pitts, a widow and sole heir of William Q. Pitts deceased, party of the first part, and Harry D. Snider of Broken Arrow I.T. party of the second part.

Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty Four Hundred Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part, the following described real estate and premises situate in the Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit: the northwest quarter of section Twenty-two (22) Township eighteen (18) North, Range Fourteen (14) East, I. M., containing one hundred sixty (60) acres more or less, the same being the lands allotted to the heirs of William Q. Pitts, deceased together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said party of the second part, his heirs executors, administrators and assigns forever.
