*Rental Contract for agricultural purposes*

Made and executed this 5<sup>th</sup> day of Oct 1907 by  
and between Betsey Bolyn of Cookson & Co.,  
party of the first part hereafter called the lessor  
and J. P. Allen party of the second part  
hereafter called the lessee.

Now therefore in consideration of  
\$10<sup>00</sup> cash payment on said rents herein prov-  
ided the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged  
the lessor rents to the lessee his successors and  
assigns the following described tracts of lands  
situated in the Cherokee Nation Indian Territory  
town: S.W.<sup>1/4</sup> of S.W.<sup>1/4</sup> and S.W.<sup>1/4</sup> of S.W.<sup>1/4</sup>  
Section 25, Township 21, Range 13, E. 5.0 acre.

To Have and to Hold said premises for agri-  
cultural purpose during the full term of - years,  
and the said lessor hereby rents the same  
for the sum of \$100 payable as follows: - \$10<sup>00</sup>  
cash the receipt of which is hereby ack-  
nowledged being full payt for first year

The lessor agrees that possession  
to above lands shall be given on or before Jan,  
1908 but if possession is not so given on or  
before said date then rents are to commence  
from date of possession.

All improvements placed on said land  
by the lessee or his assigns may be removed  
by them at or before the expiration of this  
contract.

No contract other or different from this  
shall ever be claimed by either of the parties hereto  
unless the same is in writing, and signed by  
each of them.
