 Land claim deed with relinquishment of same

This indenture made this 5<sup>th</sup> day of October A. D. 1907 between J. M. Reed, a single man of Cometa Indian Territory western District party of the first part and D. W. Jackson, and J. B. Mc Shea of Muskogee Indian Territory Western District parties of the second part

Witnesseth that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other good and valuable consideration in hand paid by the said parties of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has demised released sold, <sup>conveyed</sup> and quit-claimed and by these presents does demise release sell and convey and quit-claim unto the said parties of the second part their heirs and assigns forever all the right title interest claim and demand which said party of the first part in and to the following described lot piece or parcel of land or improvements situated in the Creek nation western district and known and described as follows to-wit:

The south-east quarter of Section fourteen 14, and the south west quarter of section fourteen 14, township eighteen 18 north range fourteen (14) east of the Indian base and meridian of the Indian Territory and according to the government survey thereof.

To have and to hold the same together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges hereunto belonging or appertaining and all estate, right, title, interest, and claims whatever of the said party of the first part either in law or equity to the <sup>whole</sup> use benefit and behoof of the said parties of the second part their heirs and assigns forever. In witness whereof the said J. M. Reed hereunto set my hand and seal this the 5<sup>th</sup> day of October A. D. 1907.
