

Deed of Trust

This indenture made and entered into this 1st day of July 1907 by and between the Jones Gas Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of Arkansas in force in Indian Territory and having its principal place of business in the City of Muskogee in Indian Territory party of the first part, and the Union Trust Company of Tulsa Indian Territory a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of Arkansas in force in Indian Territory and having its principal office in the City of Tulsa in Indian Territory as Trustee party of the second part, witnesseth that,

Whereas, the board of directors of the said The Jones Gas Company has by the authority and with the consent of the stockholders thereof legally given duly resolved to borrow the sum of Twenty Five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars for the lawful business purposes of the said company and for that purpose to execute and issue its first mortgage, eight per cent ten years, gold bonds of the par value of Five Hundred Dollars each, dated the 1st day of July 1907 and payable on the 1st day of July 1917 in Gold Coin of the United States, or of or equivalent to the present standard of weight and fineness said bonds to bear interest at the rate of eight per cent per annum, payable in gold coin quarterly annually on the first days of October, January, April and July of each year from the 1st day of July 1907 until the payment of the principal amount thereof. The payment of the principal and interest of said bonds to be secured by a mortgage or deed of trust that shall be a first mortgage on the entire property of the said The Jones Gas Company, as hereinafter described said deed of trust to be in substantially the form of this indenture and
