Know all men by these presents: That I, Joseph D. Scharble an unmarried man of Tulsa, Indian Territory, for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and no/100 (\$200.00) Dollars cash in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and confessed, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed and by these presents do hereby grant, bargain sell and convey unto the said G. M. Zimmer, of Tulsa, I. T. and unto his heirs and assigns forever all the timber standing and being upon the following lots or parcels of land lying in the Cherokee nation and within the Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The North half of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 12, Twp. 22, N. Range 12 East.

It being my intention to sell to the said G. M. Zimmer all the timber of whatsoever description standing or being upon the above described land.

To have and to hold the above described premises, together with all and singular, the rights and appurtenances thereto in anywise belonging, unto the said G. M. Zimmer — heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said premises unto the said G. M. Zimmer — heirs and assigns, against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
