The Indian office concurred in your recommendation that the petition be granted and that the applicant be permitted to sell the land above described in one tract for not less than \$250 per acre. The petition is granted and authority is hereby given Centennial Williams to alienate the N.E.^{1/4} of the S.E.^{1/4} of Section 12, Township 19 north Range 12 east, without restrictions for not less than \$250 per acre.
