App, leasing him the Homestead allotment of Ruth Johnson; that by mistake said lease was drawn describing said land as the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section twenty two (22) Township eighteen (18) north Range fourteen (14) East; that she had no interest in said land as above described at that time and has not now and never had any interest in same; that the Homestead allotment of Ruth Johnson is the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of said section twenty two (22) in same Township and Range and said lease should have been described the land as the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section twenty two (22) Township eighteen (18) north, Range fourteen (14) east, Creek Nation, Indian Territory which is the land they intended to lease and the land which has since been used by said lessee and his assignee as the land leased.

Robert Nero, being first duly sworn deposes and says; that he is the identical person who executed a certain deed to Frank L. Haymes on February 20th 1905, conveying to said Frank L. Haymes, all lands allotted to me, or to be allotted to me, as a citizen of the Creek Nation, except my Homestead; that he afterwards filed on and then was allotted to him the north half of the southwest quarter and the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section thirty-four (34), Township eighteen (18) north, Range thirteen (13) east, Creek Nation, Indian Territory; that said deed is now of record in the office of the Deputy Clerk of the United States Court, at Sapulpa, Indian Territory, in Book 2 on page 416; that he has never sold same land since same was allotted to him, but made a deed to same as security for some money borrowed.
