Made and executed this 21st day of May 1907, by and between John Caesar of Muskogee D.T. for and on behalf of himself party of the first part (hereafter called the lessor) and James B. Wright party of the second part (hereafter called the lessee).

Now, Therefore, in consideration of \$ One Dollar and other valuable consideration for the full term of five years, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the lessor rents to the lessee, his successors and assigns, the following described tracts of lands situated in the Creek Nation Indian Territory to-wit:

Northwest quarter (1/4) of the South east quarter (1/4) of section 16 Township 18 Range 14 E. 40 acres.

To Have and To Hold said premises for agricultural purpose, during the full term of 5 years. The lessor agrees that possession to above lands shall be given ^{on} or before January 1-1908 but if possession is not so given on or before said date, then rents are to commence from date of possession. All improvements placed on said land by the lessee, or his assigns, may be removed by them at or before the expiration of this contract.

No contract other or different from this shall ever be claimed by either of the parties hereto unless the same is in writing and signed by each of them. Witnessed mark: —
