This indenture made this day of - 190 - between

 first part, and Elmer M. A. Seizer party of the second
 part witnesses; that for and in consideration of the
 sum of One Hundred Dollars the receipt of which is
 hereby acknowledged, the parties of the first part
 have bargained, sold, granted, conveyed and by these
 presents hereby bargain, sell and convey to the
 party of the second part his executors, administrators
 and assigns the following described property
 the title to which we guarantee to wit: -

One Dental Chair Cabinet Engine and
 other fixtures in office of Brocken Arrow D.D.
 and that the same property is all of the kind described
 above owned and controlled by the mortgagor
 upon said premises and the above description
 and enumeration being intended to cover and
 include not only all of said property owned by
 said mortgagor as above, but any additional
 increase and accretions thereto are included
 therein. The marks and brands used to describe
 said property are the ones used in description
 as most convenient, and as the holding
 brands and carry the title although said property
 may have other marks or brands. To have and to
 hold the same unto the party of the second part
 executors, administrators and assigns forever con-
 ditioned however as follows:

 is indebted to the party of the second part in
