I know all men to these presents that we, East-End Drug Store of Tulsa in the State of Oklahoma are jointly and truly indebted unto the American Soda Fountain Co., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New Jersey and having a usual place of business in the City of Boston in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts in the sum of Three Hundred fifty Dollars as evidenced by 25 promissory notes bearing date the sixteenth day of October A.D. 1907; maturing in amounts and at times as follows: Ten Dollars April 1, 1908, twenty Dollars per month from May 1, 1908, to Sept 1, 1908, inclusive. Ten dollars per month from Oct 1, 1908 to April 1, 1909 inclusive, twenty dollars per month from May 1, 1909 to Sept 1, 1909 inclusive, Ten Dollars per month from Oct 1, 1909 to April 1, 1910, inclusive, with interest at six per cent from Apr. 1-08, which said notes were given by us for certain Soda Water Apparatus conditionally purchased by us of the said American Soda Fountain Co., and now at our place of place of business in Tulsa and which is more particularly described as one Ludlow Apparatus, Marble slab one 10 gal steel fountain, one #3 gas outfit, one rapid ice shaver, the conditions of said purchase being that possession of said property is to remain with us until default in payment but title to the same shall not pass to us but until all said notes ^{are paid} shall remain in the said American Soda Fountain Co.
