The north east quarter N.E. 1/4 of North West quarter N.W. 1/4 and South East quarter S.E. 1/4 of north west quarter N.W. 1/4 of North West quarter N.W. 1/4 of Section thirty four (34) Township Twenty-three (23) North Range Thirteen (13) East, together with all the improvements situated thereon and all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging. To have and To Hold the aforesaid premises to the said James P. Allen his heirs and assigns forever. And I, the said Jennie Bread, for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said James P. Allen of Henry Co. Mo., and his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforegranted premises; that they are free from incumbrances; that I have a good right to sell and convey the same to the said James P.
