Your Petitioner Pete Grayson guardian of the person and estate of Nettie Walker, minor child of Billie Walker respectfully represents that he is the regularly and legally appointed and acting guardian of said minor, and that acting as such he did on the 22 day of October 1907, lease to Walter M.
