COMPLAINT

Maggie Williams  
vs  
The Cherokee Co.

Lease.

Western Judicial District, Creek Nation, Indian Territory  
This Agreement, made and entered into on this the 15th day of August 1907  
by and between Maggie Williams, nee Roach party of the one part, and the  
Cherokee Company, of the other part, witnesseth:

That, the said Maggie Williams, nee Roach, for the considerations and covenants  
to be paid and performed on the part of the said The Cherokee Company, as  
hereinafter specified has this day let, leased and demised, and by these presents  
does let, lease and demise unto the said The Cherokee Company the following  
described property, to-wit: The east one half of the south east quarter of the  
south east quarter, and the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter  
of the southeast quarter of section 15 Township 20 N, Range 13 East containing  
30 acres more or less as the case may be. Said term of lease to begin on  
the 15th day of August 1907, and to continue Five years from date subject to  
the conditions and restrictions hereinafter specified and set forth.

In consideration of said leasing and renting, the said above described land,  
The Cherokee Company binds itself and promises to pay to the said Maggie  
Williams, nee Roach as rental for said property, the sum of Fifty (\$50.00)  
Dollars, cash in hand paid, receipt of same being hereby acknowledged.

— agrees to drive no nails or other things into the walls, or injure or  
in any way or manner deface the same or any part of said property.

The said The Cherokee Company, agrees to take good care of said property  
and to repair any damage done the same through their carelessness or  
neglect, at their own expense, and at the expiration of this lease to deliver  
up said property to the said Maggie Williams nee Roach, in as good  
condition as the same now is, reasonable wear and tear excepted.

The said The Cherokee Company agrees to yield quiet and peaceable possession  
of said premises to the said Maggie Williams nee Roach on the termination of this lease.
