Clinton and Jane Heard Clinton, his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1⁰⁰) Dollar, and other valuable consideration to us in hand paid by the Prairie Oil & Gas Company a corporation do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said The Prairie Oil and Gas Company and unto its successors and assigns forever the following lands, lying in the Creek nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:-

West half of south-east quarter (SW. = L. E. Bond) the north east quarter of the southeast quarter (NE. = S.E.) of Section Twenty-three (23) Township nineteen (9) north and Range twelve (12) east of the Indian Base and meridian, subject to the right of way of the Midland Valley Railway Company over and across said southeast quarter (SE. = S.E.) of Section twenty three (23) and not exceeding one hundred 100 feet in width and subject to right of way of The Texas Company recorded in book two (2), page (437) in the office of the deputy clerk of the United States Court at Tulsa Indian Territory.

To have and to hold the same unto the said the Prairie Oil and Gas Company and unto its successors, and assigns forever with all the appurtenances thereto belonging free clear of discharged of and from all former grants leases and encumbrances except a certain oil and gas lease thereon regranted in favor of Jesse R. Leonard, and hereby covenant with the said The Prairie Oil and Gas Company that we will forever warrant and defend the title to said lands against all claims whatever.
