Quit-claim Deed

This Indenture made this 23rd day of October 1907 between J. W. Orr and Eliza L. Orr his wife parties of the first part of Vinita Indian Territory northern District and Benjamin F. Barnes party of the second part of

Witnesseth: that the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars to us in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have remised released sold conveyed quit claimed and by these presents do remise release sell and convey and grant unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever the right to perpetual occupancy thereof and do also grant and assign all the right title interest claim and possession which the said parties of the first part have in and to the following described lot piece or parcel of land situated in Indian Territory and described as follows to wit:

SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 and NE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Section Four Township twenty-one Range thirteen east To Have, and To Hold the same together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, interest and claim of the said parties of the first part either in law or equity forever.
