Quit Claim Deed

Know all Men by These Presents: That the Big Jo. Lumber Company a corporation for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar cash in hand paid to it by Oscar K. Eysenback and Bessie C. Eysenback and Ethel Davis and Samuel C. Davis, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby bargain, sell, remise, release and forever quit claim unto the said Oscar K. Eysenback Bessie C. Eysenback and Ethel Davis and Samuel C. Davis all its right title interest and estate in and to the following described property to-wit:-

Lot eight (8), in Block One Hundred and nine (109) of the City of Tulsa in the Western District of the Indian Territory:

To Have and To Hold The same unto the said Oscar K. Eysenback and Bessie C. Eysenback and Ethel Davis and Samuel C. Davis their heirs and assigns forever together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging.

This deed is given for the purpose of forever satisfying and releasing, a lien held by the said Big Jo. Lumber Company upon the said above described property, under and by virtue of a mortgage executed thereon in favor of the said Big Jo Lumber Company by Oscar K. Eysenback and wife Bessie C. Eysenback and Ethel Davis and Samuel C. Davis her husband on the 28th day of September 1906; and thereafter duly recorded in Record Book No 2. Page 69 in the office of the Clerk and Ex-officio Recorder for the Western District of the Indian Territory at said City of Tulsa. The said debt secured by said mortgage having been fully paid and satisfied.
