bargained and sold and by these presents do  
bargain and sell unto the said Cassidy - South  
western Commission Company and its assigns  
the following personally property to wit:-

One hundred and eight (108) head of three year  
old steers and stags each branded thus: + (Cross)  
on the left horn or left hip. Said cattle or sheep may  
have other brands upon them than those mentioned  
above but those given are the holding brands or  
marks and carry the title to the property now  
located and running in pastures owned or leased  
by the grantors situate in Recording District No. 5  
Indian Territory about two miles S of the town  
of Broken Arrow where they are to be  
fed and cared for by and at the expense of  
the grantors said above innumeration and description
