 of the south east quarter S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the southeast
 quarter S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, Township 21 north
 Range 12 east but without warranty and Libbie
 B. Starr wife of said John C. Starr in consider-
 ation of said payment hereby relinquishes unto
 Oliver Bagby and his heirs all her right and possibility
 of sooner in and to the interest herein conveyed.

And Rachel F. Thomason wife of said John
 S. Thomason in consideration of said payment
 hereby relinquishes unto Oliver Bagby and his
 heirs all her rights and possibility of sooner
 in and to the interest herein conveyed.
