Know all men, that William Miles and Rosetta Miles Husband and wife of Vera Indian Territory, mortgagors, hereinafter called first party, to secure the payment of the sum of Twenty five $\frac{1}{2}$ % Dollars in hand paid by L.W. Clapp mortgagee, party of the second part, do hereby mortgage to the said L.W. Clapp the following described premises situated in the Creek Reservation, Indian Territory to-wit: The East ^{1/4} of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter and the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of section thirty six (36) Township twenty three (23) Range twelve (12) East of the Indian Meridian, containing in all thirty acres more or less, according to Government survey, with all the appurtenances, and warrant the title to the same.

This mortgage is made to secure the payment of the money and the performance of the agreements hereinafter agreed upon to be paid and performed by first party, to-wit:

First:- That they will pay to said L.W. Clapp, his heirs or assigns, at the office of L.W.
