Report of the Master in Chancery
To the Honorable William R. Lawrence Judge of
said Court

Oversuant to the order of reference herein
whereby this cause was referred to me to take
evidence and report the same together with my
conclusions thereon, A. A. Davidson Master
in Chancery do respectfully report as follows:

That I was attended at my office in
Muskogee I.T. on October 12th and October 13th
1907 by the plaintiff and by his counsel; witnesses
were sworn and testified evidence was heard
and received and proceedings had as more fully
appears from the transcript thereof attached
hereto and made a part of this report.

From the record and from the
evidence ^{submitted} I find:-

I That this suit was instituted by
the filing of a complaint by the plaintiff in the
office of the Clerk of this Court on November 2, 1906

II That a summons in equity was issued
on the same day; that said summons as to
the defendant Frank L. Haynes was duly and
personally served up on him in the Western
District Indian Territory on November 28th
1906; that as to the defendant E. E. Valentine
said summons was returned to the Court by
the U.S. Marshall for the Western District on
December 3, 1906 endorsed as follows:-

"The defendant E. E. Valentine was not
found in this District he being a resident
of the State of Illinois that a writ of
was issued to the defendant E. E. Valentine
on March 1, 1907 which said ^{writ} order was published
