} Deed of Release

Know all men by these presents: That I, John Dermott, a single man of West City, Missouri, for and in consideration of the sum of \$1.00 in hand paid, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Chauncey A. Owen and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following real estate, to-wit: Lot Five (5) in Block Fourteen (14) in the original town of Tulsa, Indian Territory. This deed is made and given in release of a certain mortgage given by the said Chauncey A. Owen, to the said John Dermott on the 19th day of September 1903 and filed for record in the office of the clerk of the United States Court at Sapulpa, Indian Territory, October 29, 1903, in Book "B" page 454, and the full payment of said mortgage on said lot five is hereby confessed and the land re-conveyed to the said Chauncey A. Owen.
