

and set aside as clouds upon the plaintiff's title.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed that the report of the Master in Chancery be in all things confirmed; that the deed executed by Monday Lincoln to Frank L. Haynes on the 23rd day of January 1905 and on the 18th day of May 1905, and the deed from Frank L. Haynes and Alice Haynes his wife to E. C. Valentine executed on the 26th day of June 1906, be and the same are hereby cancelled, set aside and held for naught as a cloud upon the plaintiff's title. That the plaintiff, Charles E. Trembo became the owner of the land described as the south half of the south east quarter of Section thirteen (13) Township nineteen (19) north and Range fourteen (14) east by Warranty Deed executed to him by Monday Lincoln on the 15th day of September 1906.
