Deed of Conveyance

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This Indenture made and entered into this 10th day of October One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seven by and between H. E. P. Stanford of Okmulgee I.T., party of the first part and Daniel Company of Baynton I.T., party of the second part

Witnesseth; that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents remise, release, sell, quit claim unto the party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever the following, described real estate situated in the Indian Territory, Ekelem Judicial District and known and described as follows to-wit: -

The north-half of the south-west quarter and the south-east quarter of the north-west quarter of Section thirty-two (32) in Township nineteen (19) north and Range twelve (12) east of the Indian Base and Meridian, in Indian Territory containing one hundred and twenty acres more or less as the case may be according to the United States survey thereof. To Have and to Hold the same together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereto belonging to the only use, benefit and behalf of the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever.

And I, Mary Stanford wife of the said H. E. P. Stanford for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Daniel Company all my rights of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
