Quit claim Deed.

The Indenture made and entered into this 10th day of October One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seven
day and between H. E. C. Stanford of Okmulgee I.T., party
of the first part and Daniel Company of Gaynorton I.T.,
party of the second part

Witnesseth; that the said party of the
first part for and in consideration of the sum
of One Dollar in hand paid by the said party of
the second, part the receipt of which is hereby acknow-
ledged, do by these presents remit, release, sell, quit
claim unto the party of the second part, his heirs
and assigns forever the following described
real estate situated, in the Indian Territory, Western
Judicial District and known and described as
follows to wit:-

The north half of the south-west quarter
and the southeast quarter of the north-west quarter
of Section thirty two (32) in Township nineteen 1/2
north and Range twelve 1/2 east of the Indian Base
and Meridian, in Indian Territory containing one hun-
dred and twenty acres more or less, as the case may
be according to the United States survey thereof. To
Have and to Hold the same together with all and singular
the appurtenances and privileges therunto belonging
to the only person, benefit and behalf of the said party
of the second part his heirs and assigns forever.

And I, Mary Stanford wife of the said H. E. C.
Stanford for and in consideration of the said sum of
money do hereby release and relinquish unto the
said Daniel Company all my rights of owner
and homestead in and to said lands.
