Deed of Release

Know all men by these Presents: that the Union Trust Company (an Indian Territory Corporation of Tulsa Ind Ter), for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Eighty-eight <sup>5</sup> Dollars and <sup>00</sup> Cents to it paid by Frank L. E. Ezell does hereby grant sell quit claim and release unto the said Frank L E Ezell & Florence Ezell his wife and unto their heirs and assigns forever the following described real property in the Western District of the Indian Territory town: The south fifty (50) feet of Lot three (3) in Block twelve (12) and the south fifty (50) feet of Lot four (4) in Block twelve (12) in Tulsa Indian Territory according to the official plat thereof. This deed being made to release only so far as it affects the above described property the lien of a certain mortgage dated March 3<sup>rd</sup> 1907 and recorded March 13<sup>th</sup> 1907 at 4<sup>45</sup> P.M., in Book 11 at Page 18 of the records of Mortgages at Tulsa Ind Ter. This deed of release is made by the undersigned officer of the Union Trust Company in pursuance of the authority conferred upon him in Article VII of the by-laws of said Company as follows: "The Secretary shall have equal power with the President to satisfy and release mortgages, judgments or certificates of Trust to execute contracts releases or other instruments in the transaction of the company's business." Executed this 15<sup>th</sup> day of November 1907.
