

The sum of twelve and one half (\$12.50) per cent on the proceeds of all crude oil refined from the said sand; and payment to be made on or before the 15th day of the month succeeding its extraction and sale and to pay the said amount before the 1st day of the year, the further sum of One Hundred fifty (\$150) Dollars per year for each producing gas well which may be drilled on the said premises from which gas is marketed or used for commercial purposes. It is further especially understood and agreed that the Dairy Belle Oil Company shall have the right to use its own discretion as to the commencement of the first well to be drilled on the above mentioned tract of land.
