

## Oil and Gas Lease.

This agreement made and entered into this 14<sup>th</sup> day of December A.D., 1907 by and between R E & G L Lynch and - of Tulsa Okla parties of the first part and W E. Rose of Grove Okla an Indian Territory an individual organized and doing business under and by virtue of the laws of the United States in force in the Indian Territory party of the second part

Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of The covenants and agreements hereinafter inserted and the sum of One <sup>207</sup>100 Dollars in hand and hereby acknowledged have granted demised and let unto the party of the second part his successors and assigns for the purpose and exclusive right of drilling and operating for and procuring oil and gas all on the following described property to wit: W<sup>1/2</sup> of S<sup>1/4</sup> of Sec 14 Twp 20 N Range 13 E. Cherokee Nation Okla, and the allotment of Joseph Roach deceased. Less 4<sup>1/2</sup> Acre Right of way 4<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub> A.

It is mutually agreed and understood by all parties hereto that this lease shall take the place of an oil & gas lease made on 12-25-07 on above described land and that the former lease is declared null and void situated at Tulsa Okla, to any extent the said party of the second part may deem advisable, together with the right to lay out and maintain all necessary pipe and pipe lines, tanks structures, rods cables and all other fixtures and machinery used in drilling for pumping preserving storing and transporting the product on said premises

The party of the second part shall have the right of sufficient water from the premises for operating purposes and if necessary the right to drill for it on said premises and bury all pipes on tillable land 12 inches underground
