which is hereby acknowledged, paid by Benjamin J. Maudlin to me, Frank Dubois and Lewis Dubois do, under and by authority of an order of the district court made by the Honorable William R. Lawrence on the 15th day of July 1907, empowering us so to do hereby assign, sell, transfer and convey unto Benjamin J.
