ship as Burgees Hill addition to the City of Tulsa
together with all and singular the heredita-
ments and appurtenances thereto belonging.

Do hereby said to hold the same unto the
said Second Party, his heirs and assigns, ex-
clusive, a limited time forever, and it is
further agreed that the said Second Party
shall act as the attorney, at law in the
litigation connected with the John J.
Burgess allotment until the same has
been finally determined and the Second Party
agrees to perform his duties as attorney
at law as herein specified.
