

Revised Contract

Thomas E. Mearns

To

C. E. Goodale

This agreement made and entered into this 22nd day of August, 1907

between Thomas E. Mearns of Guilford, and C. E. Goodale of Guilford, and the first part, and C. E. Goodale of Guilford, and the second part.

Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements herein after made by the first part for his, her and demise and assigns

and her heirs and assigns to the first part of the party of the second part, for agricultural purposes, for the term of five years from

and after the first day of January, 1907, the following described tract of land lying in the Chester Nation, Indian Territory:

Tract No. 17 of Section 10 Township 21 North, Range 14 East.

The said party of the second part, for the use of the said land, agree to pay to the party of the first part, as rent thereon, \$10.00 per annum

during the term of this contract, payable as follows: all cash in advance, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the party of the first part

and the second party further agree in the said party of the first part that during the term of this

lease he will give complete possession of the above land, both for himself and his minor child, Mearns Mearns, of whom he is the natural guardian,

and the party of the first part hereby agree that if he dies at any time appointed legal guardian of Mearns Mearns, then he will be such legal guardian

estate in favor of the party of the second part a legal lease on such legal guardian. In witness whereof, the parties hereunto set their hands and seals
